## **What is Cornerstone?**

Cornerstone will be the result of the redevelopment of the site of the St James Opportunity Shop and the adjoining vacant premises by St James Church Carlisle. This redevelopment will include rebuilding the premises resulting in a modern spacious development retaining the exterior character of the current buildings.

## **Aims and Objectives**

St James Church is looking to build on the ethos of the Opportunity Shop and its service to our community by providing a range of services and facilities in a new building with a friendly and welcoming atmosphere.

## **What do we hope to achieve...?**

We aim to provide a variety of services that will benefit the whole community. We have a few thoughts as to what will be here when the doors open, but the rest is really about meeting the needs of those who live in, and visit Denton Holme.

## What funding is required?

The total cost of the project is around £400,000, of which around 75% of the funding has already been achieved with a significant proportion coming from the St James congregation. The remaining £100,000 is expected to be realised through around £50,000 of grants and £50,000 through fundraising, of which this is a part. Other funding is due from other events and congregational giving. This will enable us to finish the building to a high standard, provide some capital to start running various programmes and to provide the first year's salary for the Manager/Missioner.
