Notes for Gift Aid Declaration

1. This declaration covers all donations you make to St James Church from the date of your signature.
2. You may cancel this declaration at any time.
3. You must pay income tax or capital gains tax of an amount at least equal to the total tax reclaimed by St James Church (and other charities to which you may contribute) on your donations each tax year. VAT and Council Tax do not count as tax for this purpose.
4. If your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax, you should cancel this declaration.
5. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief (which is given direct to you) by entering the amount of your donations on your tax return.
