

Micah 4:1-5 Discussion Questions

1. What does Remembrance Sunday mean for you?
2. What does it mean for you to be a peacemaker?
3. What does it mean to walk in God's paths (Micah 4:2)?
4. Through Christ's death on the cross, we can have peace with God, why is this so important? (Look at Colossians 1:19-22)
5. As well as peace *with* God, we can experience the peace *of* God. But the peace *of* God is not the absence of troubles, so what does it mean to experience the peace of God in the midst of life's troubles?
6. Jesus not only breaks down the barriers that exists between ourselves and God, but also the barriers that separate people from one another. Can you think of examples where God has done this? At the heart of breaking down barriers, is forgiveness. Why do you think many people find forgiveness so difficult? How do we begin to forgive someone who has wronged us? Is there anyone you need to forgive, or seek forgiveness from?
7. In Hebrews we read 'Make every effort to live in peace with everyone and to be holy; without holiness no one will see the Lord.' (Hebrews 12:14) What does living in peace with everyone look like in reality, and what does it mean to be holy?
